Monday

Maths

Then on the outline map of Brazil draw and label key features of human and physical geography:

Amazon River, Amazon rainforest, Sao Paulo and Rio de Janeiro, (could include football and carnival), Pantanal, pampas, coastal plains. If you find other features you can include those too.

If you find the map really tricky, you could make a poster, showing all the reasons why we might want to visit Brazil.
